Governmental Affairs Update

A lot has been going on. First, the C&T information from the EPA has been returned to MDARD. While there doesn't appear that there will be any real significant changes for our industry, regulations 636 and 637 will need to be opened back up for some fine tuning. In addition, Act 451 will also need some revisions in terms of what came back from EPA. Keep in mind when that happens, others will jump at the opportunity! They will try to make other changes detrimental to our industry. Each time a regulation is opened, it takes 18 full months and a lot of meetings to finalize. So, get ready, as I expect it will all be going on at once. Secondly, we have been looking to reintroduce the Bed Bug bill, but right now it will be held off until Q1 of next year. Anything introduced this year that doesn't get passed will be dropped and will need to be reintroduced next year. Currently, our lobbyist is working on putting it together and finding a sponsor. Our best opportunity to get it passed will be now with the current makeup of the legislature and governor's office.

HB 4858 was recently introduced, and it related to the Neonic ban and a rollback of preemption we currently have established in the state. We are setting up a meeting with the author of the bill in the next couple of weeks to discuss their intentions. Again, as I said earlier, if it doesn't get to the governor's desk this year, it must be reintroduced next year. We will be smarter on this bill once we have met with the author. Stay tuned, as I am sure this will become a serious fight moving forward if the author is serious about moving it forward.

On a national level, the Farm Bill is front and center this year. We are having a committee meeting today regarding the farm bill and probably will be reviewing alternative approaches soon. While we had the preemption language inserted in the farm bill last time through the House, it was stripped during the conference after the House and Senate passed their own forms of the farm bill.

NPMA does have a lobbyist working in Washington, DC, on this issue, and hopefully will prove to be fruitful in the end. You will continue to see VoterVOICE stuff coming your way; please make sure that you are completing the VoterVOICE campaigns. In addition to completing them, send them to your employees, family members, and whoever else will help with the campaigns. The more the better.
